The show was sold out before we started and that is always a big plus and makes us proud! Thank you Lois taking care of entries at the front gate. The Riverside East Rotary and

Our show continues to grow, especially Friday night



and along with that comes problems that none of us were expecting, including The Riverside Police Department. So here goes!

Friday night started like many of the past. Except this time rather than the typical 300-400 hot rods we get downtown early in the day feeding the parking meters, this year it seemed like there were 700-800 and growing



before we even take the streets over at 6:00PM. If you have ever seen our guys in action closing downtown and all the streets that are connected it is a pretty big undergoing. All of the guys doing it know what, where and when to do what is needed. Two problems exist, one it seemed like there was now over 1500 vehicles that

showed up and many of them unregistered and I will get to that in a minute, and the other problem is we are taking many peoples main route home away and they don't appreciate that at all, but something we have always had to deal with. Once we have the streets closed and all the barricades out the show starts rolling. Surfer Dave is rocking the place and

this is when we usually start trying to find people who are not registered and get them out, so we have room for those who have paid. Just as this was taking place we our biggest problem arrived. The Riverside Police that were working downtown monitoring all of the bars because it was Cinco de Mayo, decided to move our barricades from University be-



cause they thought the bar owners had put them out. This opened up a can of worms that not only had people driving through our closed cruise route, but also people coming out from the bars and standing in the middle of the street partying. The Police Officers assigned to our show were now at odds with the Downtown Police about who did



what and how we are going to fix this problem. After over an hour and a whole lot of work that none of us anticipated, we finally got everything resolved and closed again. While we were taking care of this situation we lost complete control of the car show and now we had spectators all in the



streets, drinking and egging cars on to do burn outs. As many of you know we nose the cars into the curbs at Show and Go as to keep the spectators out of the street and hopefully keep the cruise rout flowing. The danger with people in the streets and cars doing burn outs is the danger of someone getting hit by a car. We have all seen the

highlights on TV of a car getting out of control and hitting several people. Everyone thinks that will never happen until that one time it does. We had two really bad spots by the courthouse and right on Market St by 10th Ave. We tried our best to stop it but the crowd and people driving the cars involved became very defiant. We were seconds away from something super bad happening and Dave came up with the idea of closing the route

where it turned to go towards the courthouse and just run the cars straight down Market St. Brad heard this and headed to the far end by the Fox Theater and said "Let's just run them out and get everyone out of here". Great ideas by both, it worked and we ended the show about an hour early. Once we got everyone out and the





streets secured for the night we all just kind of looked at each other not knowing what to say! Most of the problems were caused by people who were not registered and by spectators that are not normally at our show. Finn Comer and I had a conversation wondering if we could have the show the next morning. I want to personally

thank the guys who stepped up in the middle of all the chaos, they are probably the reason nothing real bad happened. Dave Bertino, Larry Wikert, Brad Seaverson, Ken Posey, Matt Godfrey, Brian Godfrey, Steve

Johnson, George Murry, Steve Borden, Finn Comer and the guys in charge of the Teen Challenge guys. I probably left some out but not intentionally. These guys all stepped up in a matter of minutes and deserve to be mentioned. That is what team work is all about!!!! When I finally left to go home about midnight my mind was just rac-



ing about what the next day would bring us. Even though it was late and I was planning on being back at 4:30am I took the long way home and just reflected on what happened. I put myself in a few bad conflicts that thankfully ended ok. Enough about that!

Saturday started early with Larry and I trying to get the judging area closed off so people don't park in there. It is a big problem every year so this year we decided to get a jump on it. But wouldn't you know it some-






